



DAY01

ArrivalGuwahatiDriveToShillong(130KMS/3½hrsdrive)

Your amazing trip will start with your arrival at Guwahati Airport/ Station. Guwahati, 'The light of the East' is the commercial capital of North East lying adjacent to the shores of the turbulent Brahmaputra.

Start your journey Shillong a beautiful hill station also known as the "Scotland of the East" is the capital city of Meghalaya and one of the major tourist destinations of East India. En route visit Umiam Lake or Barapani - is the biggest artificial lake in Meghalaya in midst of sylvan hills adorned by Khasi pines & peerless beauty.

Later visit Don Bosco Museum (closed on Sundays and Christian holidays), Cathedral of Mary, Golf Course and Ward's Lake.

After reaching Shillong, check into your hotel. Evening free at leisure to explore the region on your own. You may take a walk to the famous Police Bazaar for shopping, where you can enjoy the scenic beauty of the lake.

Overnight in Shillong.



Day2

Shillong–Cherrapunjee–Shillong(60KMs/2hrs-Oneway)

After a satisfying breakfast leave for a sightseeing at the wettest place on the Earth! Yes, we are talking about Cherrapunji, which holds the all-time record for the most rainfall in a calendar month and in a year.

In Cherrapunjee be witness to the gorgeous Seven Sisters (Nohsngithiang) Falls and Nohkalikai Falls. Later take a soft cave walk inside the Mawsmai Cave. The limestone cave is a natural wonder with innumerable formations inside it. Also visit the Garden of Caves.

After a joyful day drive back to Shillong. Overnight in Shillong. Note:

Most of the waterfalls are dry during winter season.



Day 3

Shillong-Mwallynong-Dawki-Shillong(100kms/3hrs/oneway)

After a delicious breakfast drive to Mwallynong, the cleanest village in Asia, also known as 'God's own Garden'. With over 80 households, the village gives the ambience of walking in a well-maintained park! You will also be acquainted to the Khasi lifestyle, their culture and economy.

Walk down a flight of almost 100 steps to witness nature's wonder, living-root bridge. The bridges are tangles of massive thick roots, which the local people inter-twine to form a bridge that can hold several people at a time.

Later drive to Dawki, a village of the Jaintia community whose prime occupation is fishing. Be mesmerized by the beauty of the Umngot river. The river is famous for its crystal clear water. The Umngot river is the natural boundary between Ri Pnaror Jaintia Hills with Hima Khyrim of Khasi hills over which a single span suspension bridge was constructed. This is the gateway to Bangladesh where major export and import transactions take place. Enjoy an amazing country boat river ride (at additional cost boat ride at additional cost). Drive up to the Bangladesh border. Later proceed to Shillong. Overnight in Shillong.

Note: It is advisable to carry packed lunch to Mwallynong.



Day 4

Shillong-Guwahati(110kms/3hrs/)

After breakfast check-out from the hotel. A unique experience of soul-probing expedition through the lush state with this breath-taking package ends today. You'll be transferred to the Guwahati Airport as it's time to say goodbye with cherishable memories.

- Early birds get the best deal The region does not have star category hotels.
- Generally there isn't any star categorization in this sector, however the same is demarcated as per prices and put into slabs of 2*/ 3*/ 4* or STD/ DLX/ PRM or equivalent.
- Packages are based on base category rooms, irrespective of the Hotel category opted.
- Room up-gradation payable at the hotel directly For large groups, all rooms in one hotel may not be available.
- So if two or more hotels are selected, identical facilities may not be available between rooms.
- We expect you to adjust to these conditions.
- We will however try our best to maintain similarity.
- Please be reminded that all special requests like early check-in, smoking, nonsmoking, views, floors, king, twin, adjoining and/or interconnecting rooms are strictly subject to availability upon arrival and cannot be guaranteed prior.
- Any expenses arising out of this is to be borne by the customer.
- All hotels do not have lift facility and the guest may have to climb stairs. Incase of guests having problems with blood pressure, breathing, knee and heart or if they cannot climb the higher floors, we request you to update this at the time of booking so that we may take appropriate action and try for rooms in the Ground floor.
- This is again subject to availability and DIFFERENCE IF ANY WILL HAVE TO BE SETTELED DIRECTLY BEFORE CHECK OUT.
- Most of the Hotels in this region do not have Tea/coffee maker/ mini fridge/ enhanced toiletry kit (with moisturizer, tooth paste, brush, shaving kit, lufa, bathroom sleepers, bath-robe) etc. For meal plans, menu will be on fixed plan/ buffet basis and not on A-la-Carte basis.
- MAP and AP Meal plans do not include Evening snacks and cold drinks / liquor, Soups or Deserts.
- For order on A-la-Carte basis, guests are requested to make direct payment for additional items.
- For early morning check out breakfast may be limited to simple bread and butter / jam with tea/ coffee/ juice.
- Request for such items will have to be made at the time of booking.
- Consumption and serving of alcohol in hotels / rooms is subject to hotel's rules and regulations.
- Kindly inform guests that same category rooms or identical rooms may not be available as the structure is not designed accordingly.
- In most hotels Extra Person Sharing the Room, Child With Extra Bed, will be provided MATTRESS / ROLL OVERS as per availability and not a Bed. In hilly areas, scarcity of water and electricity is a natural phenomenon.
- To overcome the water crisis certain hotels have fixed schedule for supplying hot and cold water. We strongly regret the inconvenience and look forward for your cooperation.
- In hills, most of the hotels are located in a way where the view might be of a building in the front, beside or behind it.
- Check-in time at Hotel will be 1400 Hrs and Check-out time will be 1000 Hrs.
- For early check in / late checkout / extending of stay, will be completely subjected to the availability as per the situation.

- As imposed by the Government Valid photo ID for all members staying at the hotel is mandatory.
- MOST of the hotels do not have parking place and vehicle cannot be parked in front of the gates for longer period hence guests should wait at the reception 10 minute before the departure to avoid the inconveniences.
- Room heaters if required can be provided on chargeable basis, subject to availability.
- Connectivity (phone as well as internet) is poor and unreliable in North East.
- Most hotels will not have a Wi-Fi connection.
- Transport Due to unforeseen situations (force majeure/ traffic jams / traffic halts/ diversions/ bandh/ curfew, Union strike, VVIP movement, etc.) the vehicle reporting may get delayed.
- We will request you to bear with us and as soon as vehicle arrives you will have to get in asap.
- Due to vehicle-parking difficulty, most of the areas are restricted to entry of vehicle and specific time is allotted for entries.
- Kindly follow the time strictly as given to you.
- The vehicle used will not be at disposal and will be exclusively used as per the itinerary only (on point to point basis). wise.

- So if you have a transfer to another destination in second half, please maintain time of your morning sightseeing If one destination/ sightseeing point is covered twice or additional destinations are included, additional charges will be applicable on per km / per hour basis.

Important Safari in National Parks:

- Most National Parks remain open only from 1 November - 30 April Jeep Safari may continue in May / October depending on flood situation.
- Safari in October and May is limited within a few kms and is subject to flood situation

Safari seating arrangement :

Jeep Safari -1 jeep accommodates 6 persons and can be hired individually

For pre-booked Safari with us : ·

- Counter for Safari tickets open at 5:30 pm and tickets are issued only for the next day.
- We cannot pre-purchase
- safari tickets. Tickets are issued as per Forest Department rules ·
- Safari is managed by our representative in the region who would provide details in the evening at about 7:30 - 8:00 pm and provide all required information.
- Kindly inform the guest not to re-book safari (if we have already confirmed in our voucher) in the hotel/ resort of their stay.
- No refunds will be entertained for such booking.
- We are not responsible for cancellation of safari.
- The Safari is managed by the Forest Department and many times tickets are not allotted for tourists due to VIP / Government movement or for anti-poaching / census drives.
- · No Refunds for safari will be applicable.
- Important Guidelines Guests with adventurous mind should travel to Arunachal Pradesh.
- Special Note for Arunachal Pradesh ·
- Arunachal Pradesh is very remote place, so all hotels in this region are basic to very very basic. Road conditions from Bhalukpong to Tawang are not good.
- Room heaters may not work in Arunachal Pradesh due to voltage fluctuations.
- In this region there are no relevance between the distance and time travelling as it depends upon the conditions of roads and congestion of traffic.

- Mobile services may not be active in all destinations.
- Pre-paid roaming and International roaming connection does not work in this region.
- We suggest carrying BSNL (GSM) connections.
- Credit Cards / Traveller's cheque are not freely accepted. Inner Line Permit for entry to Arunachal Pradesh To visit Arunachal Pradesh, Indian national requires Inner Line Permits.
- Permits are issued in Guwahati which takes 2-3 working days. (ILP office remains closed on Saturday-Sunday) Documents required for every traveler:
- 2 passport size photographs of each person ·
- 1 Valid Photo ID proof (Adhaar Card, Driving License, Voter ID Card, Valid Passport) ·
- Pan Card is not accepted as ID proof by the authorities ·
- 1 Valid Address proof Health Advisory ·
- Enroute to Tawang, there is Sela Pass at 13,700 ft.
- The area has low oxygen and may cause High altitude sickness, nausea, shortness of breath etc.
- If guests have health problems like blood pressure, asthma, and heart related issue etc.
- kindly advise them to consult their doctors ·
