



DAY 01

Arrival Guwahati Drive To Shillong (130 KMS / 3 ½ hrs drive)

Your amazing trip will start with your arrival at Guwahati Airport/ Station. Guwahati, 'The light of the East' is the commercial capital of North East lying adjacent to the shores of the turbulent Brahmaputra.

Start your journey Shillong a beautiful hill station also known as the "Scotland of the East" is the capital city of Meghalaya and one of the major tourist destinations of East India. Enroute visit Uiam Lake or Barapani - is the biggest artificial lake in Meghalaya in midst of sylvan hills adorned by Khasi pines & peerless beauty.

Later Visit Don Bosco Museum (closed on Sundays and Christian holidays), Cathedral of Marry, Golf Course and Ward's Lake.

After reaching Shillong, check-in to your hotel.

Evening free at leisure to explore the region on own. You may take a walk to the famous Police Bazaar for shopping. where you can enjoy the scenic beauty of the lake.

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Day2

Shillong - Cherrapunjee - Shillong (60 Kms / 2 Hrs - One Way)

After a satisfying breakfast leave for a sightseeing at the wettest place on the Earth! Yes, we are talking about Cherrapunji, which holds the all-time record for the most rainfall in a calendar month and in a year.

In Cherrapunjee be witness to the gorgeous Seven Sisters (Nohsngthiang) Falls and Nohkalikai Falls. Later take a soft cave walk inside the Mawsmai Cave. The limestone cave is a natural wonder with innumerable formations inside it. Also visit the Garden of Caves.

After a joyful day drive back to Shillong.

Overnight in Shillong.

Note: Most of the waterfalls are dry during winter season.



Day 3

Shillong - Mwalynong - Dawki - Shillong (100 Kms/ 3 Hrs/ One Way)

After a delicious breakfast drive to Mwalynong, the cleanest village in Asia, also known as 'God's own Garden'. With over 80 households, the village gives the ambiance of walking in a well maintained park ! You will also be acquainted to the Khasi lifestyle, their culture and economy.

Walk down a flight of almost 100 steps to witness nature's wonder, living-root bridge. The bridges are tangles of massive thick roots, which the local people inter-twined to form a bridge that can hold several people at a time.

Later drive to Dawki, a village of the Jaintia community whose prime occupation is fishing. Be mesmerized by the beauty of the Umngot river. The river is famous for its crystal clear water. The Umngot river is the natural boundary between Ri Pnar or Jaintia Hills with Hima Khyrim of Khasi hills over which a single span suspension bridge was constructed. This is the gateway to Bangladesh where major export and import transactions take place. Enjoy an amazing country boat river ride (at additional cost boat ride at additional cost). Drive up to the Bangladesh border.

Later proceed to Shillong .

Overnight in Shillong.

Note: It is advisable to carry packed lunch to Mwalynong.



Day 4

Shillong - Tezpur (250 Kms / 6 Hrs)

This morning after a pleasant breakfast drive to Tezpur.

After reaching Tezpur check-in your hotel & relax as rest of the evening is at leisure. If time permits, visit Mahabhairav temple.

Day 5

Tezpur - Dirang (190 Kms/ 5 Hrs)

This morning after breakfast drive to Dirang (4910 ft). Visit the TDL Monastery (Thupsung Dhargye Ling Monastery).

Check in Hotel. Evening at Leisure.

Day 6

Dirang - Tawang (155 Kms / 6 Hrs)

After a breakfast drive to Tawang (10,000 ft) Tawang is the beautiful land of the Monpa tribes. 'The Land of Dawn-lit Mountains' at 3500 mts gives you unparalleled purity of nature.

En route witness the unique Dirang Valley famous for its monasteries, hot Springs, Apple & kiwi Orchards, sheep breeding farms & charming valleys. Also witness the snowcapped Sella Pass at 13700 ft and the Jaswant Garh War Memorial.

After reaching Twang check-in your hotel & relax as rest of the evening is at leisure.

Day 7

- Tawang
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- After a breakfast visit the Tawang Monastery also known as the “GALDEN NAMGYEL LHATSE” is one of the largest Lamaseries of Mahayana sect in Asia and is the largest of its kind in India. The Monastery is 400 year old and is adorned with the 18 feet high statue of Lord Buddha. It stands at 10,000 feet amidst the exotic Himalayan ranges and overlooks the Tawang-Chu valley. Later visit The Urgelling Monastery which is located 5 km from Tawang city, and is the birth place of the 6th Dalai Lama, born in the 17th century. The monastery was established by the Lama Urgen Sangpo in the 15th century.
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- Also visit Ani Gompa and the Buddha Statue
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- Later visit the War Memorial commemorating the bravery of the Indian heroes of the Indo-China war of 1962. Witness the light & sound show in the evening.
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- After full day sightseeing driver back to hotel in Tawang
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- Overnight in Tawang.

Day8

Tawang - Bomdila (180 Kms / 6 hrs)

After breakfast drive to Bomdila. At a height of 8000 ft., Bomdila is a small town famous for its Buddhist monasteries, magnificent valleys and Himalayan landscapes.

En route visit the Jung Falls also known as "The Nuranang falls" @6000 feet is located about 40 km before reaching Tawang is famed as one of the most stunning waterfalls in North East India. The falls height is about 100 meters. The legend about the waterfalls goes that it is named after a Monpa girl Nura who aided an Indian soldier during the 1962 Sino-Indian War.

After reaching Bomdila check-in your hotel & relax as rest of the evening is at leisure.
