Next, head to the Asahi Super Dry Museum, where you'll dive into the history of Japan's iconic beer. The museum's modern design pairs perfectly with the season, offering a cozy retreat as you learn about the brewing process and savour a refreshing taste of Asahi. Finally, end your day with a

visit to Kairakuen Garden, one of Japan's most beautiful gardens, especially in autumn. The vibrant colourful leaves create a breathtaking landscape, perfect for a peaceful stroll or a moment of reflection amidst nature's splendour





Day 3

<u>Visit Aqua WorldlbarakiOarai Aquarium-Visit</u> RyujinSuspensionBridge-Visit Fukuroda Falls

After breakfast, begin your day with a visit to Aqua World Ibaraki Oarai Aquarium, home to awide variety of marine life, including mesmerizing dolphin shows and interactive exhibits. Next, head to the Ryujin Suspension Bridge, Japan's longest suspension bridge, offering panoramic views of the scenic countryside and surrounding nature.

Day 5

Later, enjoy a relaxing Lake Ashi Cruise, where you can take inbreathtaking view so fthe surrounding mountains and serene waters of Lake Ashinoko.

Note: Hakonevalley experiences strong winds. Incase of extreme weather conditions, access to above sites or visibility is restricted.



Day6

Then, we visit the aweinspiring To daiji Temple, famous for its colossal Daibutsu (Great Buddha) statue, one of Japan's most iconic sights. In the evening, immerse yourself in the vibrant energy of Shinsaibashi, Osaka's premier shopping district, where you can browse through trendy boutiques, savor delicious street food, and experience the lively pulse of the city.
