Day 3

Owakudani Ropeway- Visit Owakudani Boiling Valley- Lake AshiCruise- OshinoHakkai View point of Mount Fuji

After breakfast, we will head to Owakudani and take the Owakudani Ropeway to explore Owakudani Valley. Enjoy a scenic cruise on Lake Ashi, taking in the stunning views of the surrounding mountain sand LakeAshinoko. Later, visit Oshino Hakkai Viewpoint of Mount Fuji, where you can see Japan's highest peak and a UNESCO World Heritage Site.
